# Seventy Weeks

## Daniel 9:24

- Weeks = Sevens or seventy sevens
- $70 \times 7 = 490$  ? (days, years, non specific)
- Fulfillment of six things
  - To finish the transgression
  - To make an end of sins
  - To make reconciliation for iniquity
  - To bring in everlasting righteousness
  - To seal up vision and prophecy
  - To anoint the Most Holy

# Seventy Weeks

## Daniel 9:25

- Seven Weeks = 49 years
- Sixty-Two Weeks = 434 years
- -----
- Sixty Nine Weeks = 483 years
- One Week = 7 years
- -----
- Seventy Weeks = 490 years
- From – Until - After

## Daniel 9:25

- From:
  - The Decree of Cyrus  
Ezra 1:1-4 ( 539-538 BC)
  - The Decree of Arataxerxes  
Ezra 7:13-14 (457 BC)
  - The Second Decree of Arataxerxes  
Nehemiah 2:1-8 (445-444 BC)

# Seventy Weeks

## Daniel 9:25

- Until:
  - The Messiah the prince



# Seventy Weeks

## Daniel 9:26-27

- After:
  - Messiah will be cut off, but not for Himself
  - People of the prince who is to come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary
  - For one week He shall confirm a covenant with many
  - In the middle of the week He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering
  - The abomination and desolation to come

# Seventy Weeks of Daniel 9

- The Passage is admittedly difficult.
- We must lose not sight of the confirmation of these prophecies:
  - The city of Jerusalem would be rebuilt
  - The city of Jerusalem would be destroyed
  - The end of vision and prophecy

# Seventy Weeks of Daniel 9

- We also must not lose sight of the wonderful promises that we can receive because of the death of the Messiah:
  - The end of sins
  - The everlasting righteousness
